“Hospital shuts baby unit after infection kills three newborns - Northern Ireland health minister asks parents to remain calm”

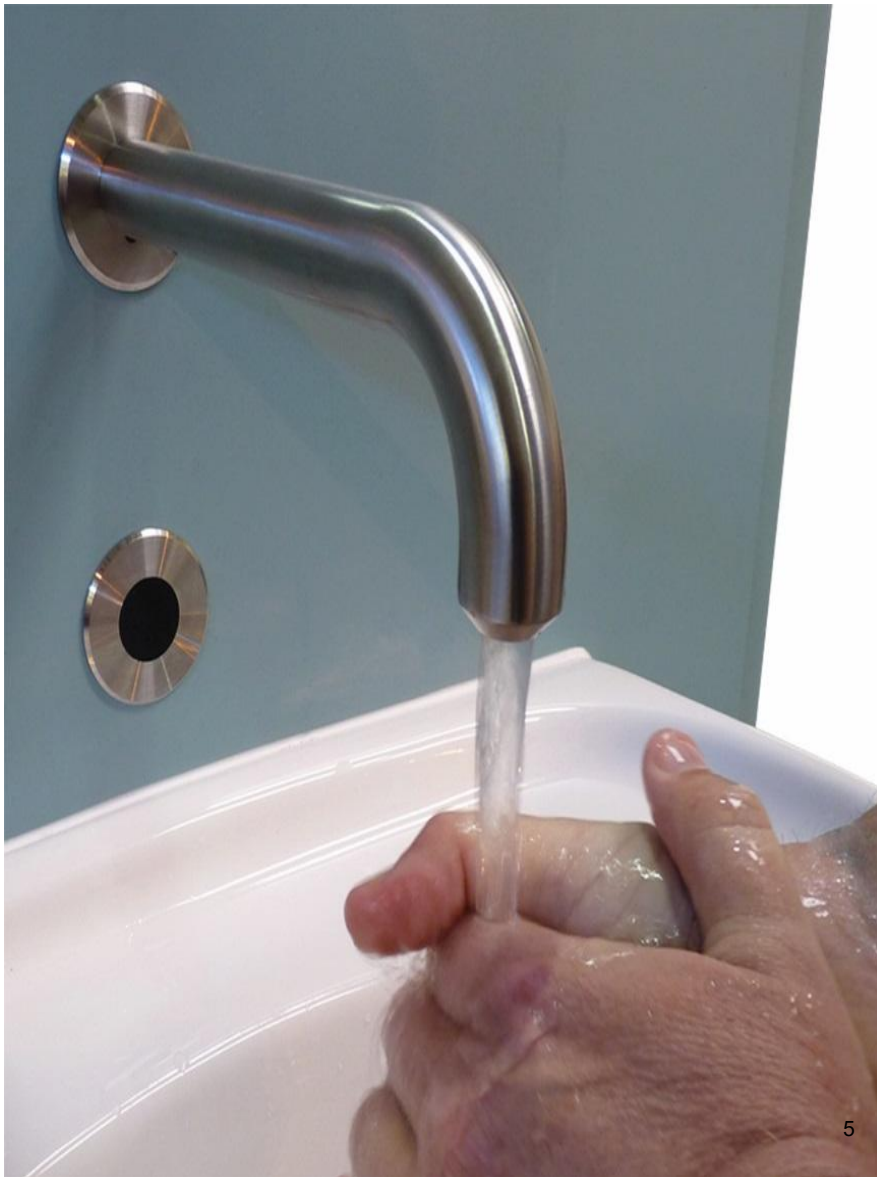

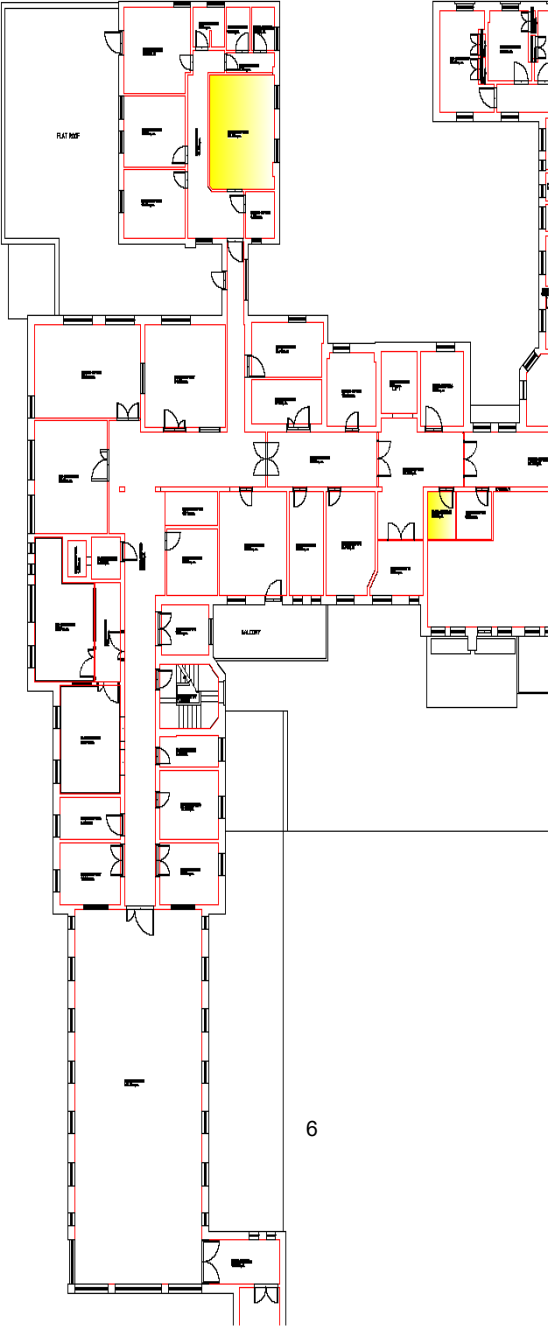

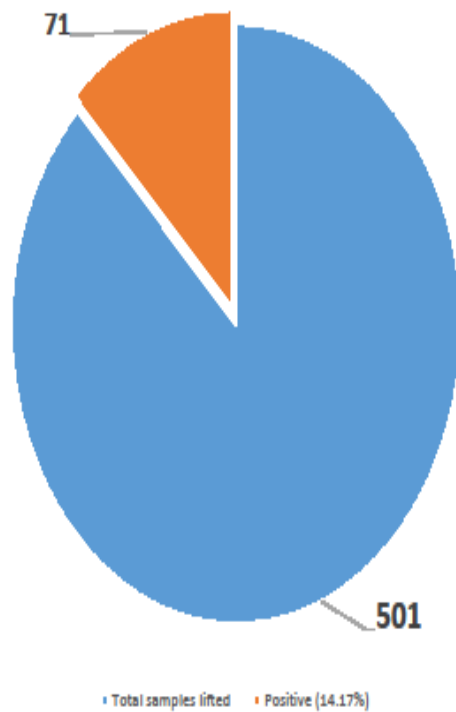








RICU Pseudomonas samples 2012-2013
