- •cost of running and providing clinical services Less well known "90% of all medicines work for 30-50% of all patients". = Need for Precision Medicine and Al
- •Internal NHS Staff/ department -need identified in day to day work
- Supplier approach to adverse incidents or product improvement
- Key Source of economic growth and job creation



Minimising risk of Innovation





- Establishing support and buy in from users and budget holders
- •Consult widely with the right stakeholders to determine specifications and requirements
- •Clinical evidence- Determine efficacy using trials, test beds, HTA's etc
- •Certification and Registration- Ensure relevant CE marking is applied.
- Apply policy and procedure e.g. Policy for use, Procedure for procurement




