

This information message is sent to draw the attention of Equipment Co-ordinators to information which may be relevant to the safety of equipment and facilities in NHS Boards and Local Authorities. Please find the information below.

<u>Summary</u>

Certain models of Hotpoint and Indesit washing machines manufactured between 2014 and 2018 have faulty door locking mechanisms which can overheat and cause fire. Whirlpool issued an initial product recall in December 2019. However, it has recently **added a further 21 model numbers to the recall.** This

If your washing machine has been recalled, Whirlpool state that you will be able to choose between two options:
