

Epidemiology of healthcare associated infections in Scottish LTCF

5.9% of residents had one HCAI or more at the time of survey.

On average, this is approximately **3** residents in every adult LTCF

- Median age of residents with HCAI was **85** years.
- Older age was independently associated with having a HCAI

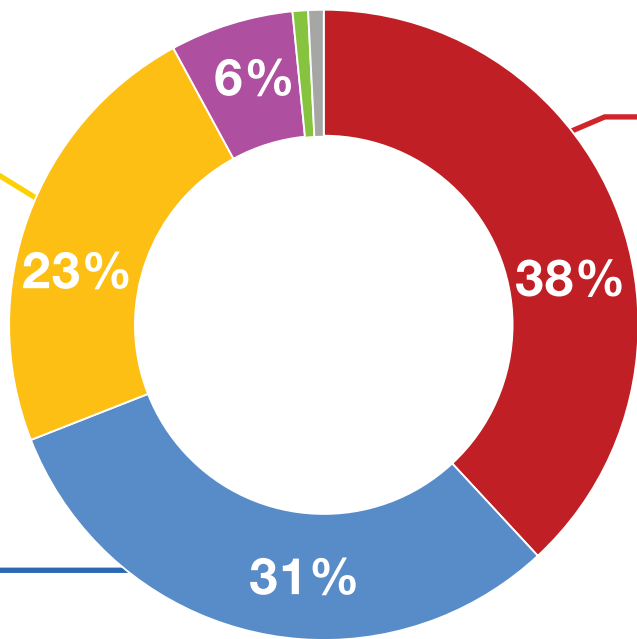


Infection types

1.4% (95% CI 1.0 to 2.0) of all residents had a SSTI at the time of survey

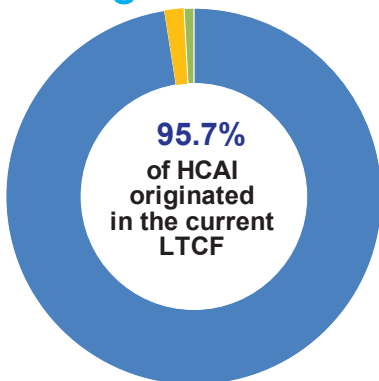
1.9% (95% CI 1.4 to 2.5) of all residents had a UTI at the time of survey

2.3% (95% CI 1.7 to 3.0) of all residents had a RTI at the time of survey
