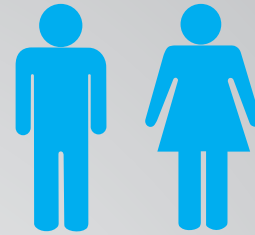
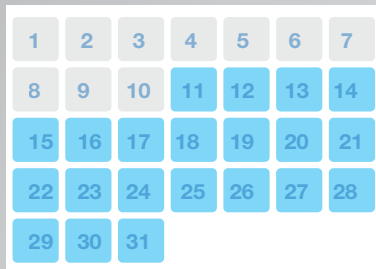


What do Scottish non-acute hospitals look like?

Characteristics of NHS non-acute hospitals



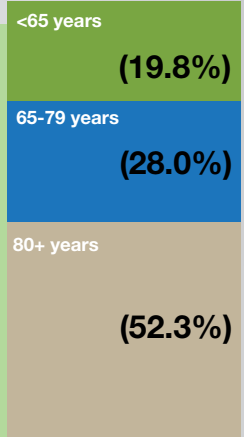
The average length of stay in the survey hospitals in 2016 was

37.4 days

Male to female ratio **1:1.4**



Data from **1083** eligible patients in **77** wards in **24** hospitals

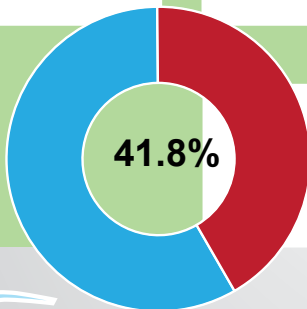
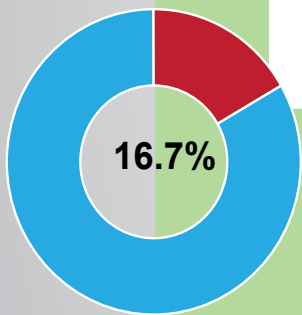


The median age of patients was

80 years

16.7% of staff surveyed were carrying personal ABHR

41.8% of beds had ABHR at point of care



The occupancy of hospital beds in surveyed wards was

84.4%
