Good morning

Please find closure messages for INV825 OCC1019. The closing findings states:

During the period of incidents, endoscopes were subjected to manual pre-cleaning followed by cleaning and disinfection process in automated EWDs despite using the chemicals previously have not been validated for these machines. Both SeptoPac and Amity PAA contain the same active ingredient i.e. peracetic acid. Based upon the low volume of Amity PAA15 used in the EWD 009145, NHS Grampian was confident only few endoscopes were processed using Amity PAA 15. Eleven endoscopes processed on 12 and 13 June 2017, ten of them were successfully recalled. According to NHS Grampian Infection Prevention and Control (IPC), there is no reason to believe there has been any adverse exposure to patients. Health Protection Scotland was notified by NHS Grampian with a green classification in the Healthcare Infection Incident Assessment Tool. Recommendations have been made (see report)
