
## **SITUATION**

The Scottish Executive Nurse Group (SEND) have commissioned a SLWG to review the current ostomy product prescribing practice and advise on models of care that would support a regional / national approach to optimise quality, equity and cost effective stoma prescribing practice.

This SBAR is to communicate to key stakeholder groups for nominations to a National Stoma Optimisation SLWG that is being developed with first meeting arranged for **22.01.18** 

## **BACKGROUND**

NHS Scotland **community** ostomy expenditure is currently **£31 million** per annum with a trend of increasing expenditure; (65% over 5 years) Fig1



65% increase over 5 years


The Stoma Care in the Community Report (2016) identified that all areas of ostomy exceeded the prescribing triggers; identifying waste and variation which supports the need for clinical leadership to drive improvements at local, regional and national level.

## **ASSESSMENT**

<u>April 2017</u>: A paper presented by NSS Executive Nurse Director to Scottish Executive Nurse Group (SEND) highlighted that high spend commodity areas such as ostomy lack well developed governance structures that are in place for other high expenditure areas detailed in **Fig 2**, which supports the need to identify a national approach to optimise use, reduce waste and variation and support Health Board efficiency targets

Key to this was establishing clinical leadership to drive direction and improvement





Examples of commodity areas where there are national groups established to coordinate, lead and deliver various activities that facilitate cost effective reduction in expenditure and optimise care delivery.

SEND recommended that the Scottish Deputy Nurse Director Group provide the leadership to support a national stoma optimisation SLWG which will be chaired by Craig Stewart ADoN, IJB lead Nurse East Ayrshire.

The SLWG will require to identify key stakeholder members identified as

- Colorectal Clinician :
- Stoma Nurse Representation: (North, South, East & West)
- G.P Representation
- Non Medical Prescribing representation( North , South , East & West)
- Health Board Pharmacist
- ISD Analyst (NSS)
