### **Independent Authorising Engineer**

Policy & Essential Requirements & Purpose of Role, Appointment



**National Policy Requirement** 

Set out in relevant HTM Technical Guidance.

**Essential Requirements of Role** 

**Authorised Accredited Professional Engineers.** 

**Key Purpose of Role** 

**Provide Independent Professional Advice.** 

**Monitor & Audit Hospital Operational Performance & Compliance.** 

**External Assessor For The Appointment of Authorised & Competent Staff.** 

**Appointment** 

All AE services must be appointed by the client in writing.

AE should be independent of the organisation structure.

### IHEEM Authorising Engineer Professional Independent Governance Process



- 1) IHEEM Specialises in the Healthcare Sector and is Licensed by the Engineering Council.
- 2) The largest UK Professional Body dedicated to research & development and professional development of healthcare engineers and facilities managers.
- 3) "IHEEM Authorising Engineer" Is a Professional Registration developed and managed by IHEEM. All appointed AE's who are given this title have been through a rigorous, Independent, and professional, transparent process.
- 4) The route to accreditation is assessed through a combination of academic and professional experience, practice reports and professional review.
- 5) All practising AE's must keep up to date through CPD, record onsite activities and renew their registration every three years, and comply with the IHEEM code of practice.

### **Next Steps**



- 1) Marketing & Raising Awareness of the importance of Professional AE services.
- 2) Working with Devolved Nations to strengthen policy and governance.
- 3) Working with International partners to strengthen professional advice to WHO.
- 4) Working with specialist training providers to provide specialist training.
- 5) Developing professional registers and career paths for AP & CP (The important but often forgotten group)
