Who better to help than those who use the system the most – your colleagues!

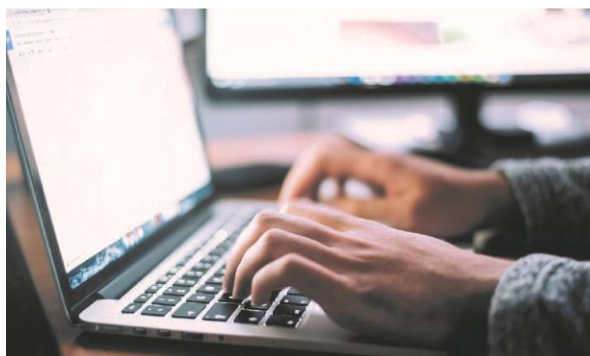

NPCCD Key Developments:

Medical

- Currently Business as Usual

Ophthalmic

- If you run into issues updating a clinician's Part 1 or Part 2 listing statuses or Part 1 listed contractor's Practice Association information, please check the existing data (both open and closed) to ensure they meet the following validation rules:
 - Listing status for a particular Health Board cannot overlap e.g. a Part 1 entry cannot end on the same day as a Part 2 entry begins, and vice versa.
 - In order to be associated with a practice, the contractor must already be on Part 1 of the Ophthalmic List of the Health Board in which the practice is located.
- **Reminder:** Before removing a Part 1 listed contractor's association with a practice, you must ensure that afterwards the practice will still have at least one contractor associated with it- if not, GOS can no longer be provided at or from that practice.
- **New development:** NPCCD Clinician Data Access will be entering Phase 2 user testing in the next few weeks. We will be in touch with Health Boards in due course regarding this, including to seek volunteer testers.

Dental

- After a bit of a pause, we are pleased to confirm that Phase 2 of Dental Development has recommenced. We will keep you informed of any pertinent information in the coming months.
