Technician to Paramedic Education Pathways

NES is working in partnership with Scottish Ambulance Service to explore earn while learn education pathways from technician to paramedic:

- For 12 years, SAS and Glasgow Caledonian University (GCU) have worked in partnership to deliver a Health and Care Profession Council (HCPC) approved 'Diploma in Higher Education (Dip HE) in Paramedic Practice'.
- Students on this programme were SAS employees. This SAS internal career progression route supported the technician workforce to 'earn-and-learn' to the point of eligibility to apply for professional registration as a paramedic.
- Due to changes in the threshold of training and education for paramedics, this route is expired with no replacement 'earn-and-learn' alternative.
- SAS are working in partnership with NES in an effort to re-establish an earn-and-learn technician to paramedic progression route. The first phase (Phase 1) of this work was to explore any potential viable options/solutions.
- A report has been produced with 4 potential options with a favoured option being a collaboration with SQA and HEIs: SQA without FutureQuals (FQ) and with Degree Award (SAS/SQA/CS/HEI)*
- Phase 2 of the work to commence collaboration with SQA who have produced a business case for SAS has not been approved with Scottish Government requiring more work is done on all options to establish costing implications. SG is funding a project officer from NSS to support this.
- The NES SAS partnership is supporting this costing implications work whilst also exploring emerging advanced standing routes for technicians to join some of the HEIs delivering BSC paramedics in year 2 of their programmes. It is acknowledged this is not an earn while learn route and is not an option across all HEIs in Scotland.
- An alternative option of an Apprenticeship Degree is out with the control of NES as many different health professions are vying for the opportunities for graduate apprenticeship development.
